

2010 NIST Speaker Recognition Evaluation Early Registration Form

To receive for system development purposes the NIST SRE data from the 2008 and prior NIST speaker recognition evaluations, and participate in the 2010 NIST Speaker Recognition Evaluation, this registration form must be filled out in its entirety and returned to NIST by the early registration deadline of **December 31, 2009**. A different registration form, with a March 2010 deadline, will be available in early 2010.

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The following are terms of participation in the 2010 NIST Speaker Recognition Evaluation:

- Sites must sign the LDC's 2010 NIST Speaker Recognition Evaluation License Agreement before receiving the development, and later the evaluation, data. See link at: <http://www.nist.gov/speech/tests/sre/2010/index.html>
- On receiving the evaluation data (in the spring of 2010), the registered site will process the entire test set in accordance with the SRE10 evaluation plan (to be made available by January, 2010) and return the system output files to NIST by the end of the specified evaluation period in May, 2010.
- The site agrees to be represented at the Speaker Recognition Evaluation workshop to be held in Brno, the Czech Republic, **June 24-25, 2010** and to openly discuss its evaluation system(s) and results.
- The site understands that, although the evaluation is open to all wishing to participate, the workshop is open only to representatives of the registered participants and supporting government agencies, and the distribution of the workshop materials is limited to the attendees of the workshop.
- The development evaluation data is protected and cannot be redistributed.
- In reporting and comparing its results with the results of other sites, the site agrees to follow rules specified in the SRE10 evaluation plan. In particular, sites are free to do what they wish with their own presentation, but may neither redistribute nor publish presentations from another site without that site's explicit permission.

NIST serves to coordinate the Speaker Recognition evaluations. These tests are designed for local implementation by each participant. Only their results are returned to NIST for scoring. The reported results are not to be construed, or represented, as endorsement of any participant's system, or as official findings on the part of NIST or the U.S. Government.
